

CASE STUDY

OVERVIEW

A quality home in a newly developed suburb in Auckland, New Zealand was built for a family with young children. With safety a main concern a solution was sought for securing the kitchen cabinets from these inquisitive children. Top priority was a device that didn't upset the look of the new kitchen with ease of use and effectiveness also important considerations.

Proposed by the kitchen manufacturer the YC10 Cabinet locking system was chosen as it met all the requirements of the new owner. The design of the kitchen dictated there was two distinctly separate areas that required locking, one area against the wall and the other a free standing island. A two lock starter pack was used in each area with additional locks daisy chained in. Backup batteries were added in each location to allow access even in the event of a power failure.

A total of eighteen locks were successfully installed on both cupboards and drawers and proved very effective at keeping curious children safe.
